With reference to the inspection report of your school subsequent correspondence with the school/ inspection in this regard. I convey the grant of provisional recognition to Shri Usha Mata Public School, Dulladi Gate Nabha, Patiala for class I to class VIII till 31-3-2025.

The above sanction is subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions,

namely:-

- The grant for recognition is not extendable and does
- not in any imply any obligation to recognize/affiliate beyond class VIII.
- The school shall abide by the provisions of the diRight of children to free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 (Annexure 1) and Right of children to free and Compulsory Education Rules 2011 (Annexure II)
- 4. The School Shail Admit in class I, to the extent of 25% of the strength of that class, children belonging to the weaker section and the disadvantages group in the neighborhood and provide free and compulsory elementary education (id its completion).

Provided, that is case of pre-primary classes also, this norm shall be

- 5. For the children referred to in paragraph 3, the school shall be reimbursed as a per sub-section 2 on the section of the 12 of the Act. To receive such rein bursement, the school shall provide a separate bank account.
- The school shall not collect any capitation fee and subject the child of his or her
 parents of guardians to any screening Procedure.
- 7. The school shall not derry admission-
 - (a) to any take for lack of age proof; of
 - (b) If such a unission is sought subsequent to the extended period prescribed to advantaions or

- (c) On the ground of religion, cast or race, place of birth of any of these reasons.
- 8. The school shall ensure that:-
 - (a) no child admitted, shall be held back in any class or expelled from school till the completion of elementary Education in a school;
 - (b) no child shall be subjected to physical punishment of mental harassment;
 - (c) no child require to pass any board examination till the completion of elementary education;
 - (d) every child completing elementary education shall be awarded a certificate as laid down under rule 21;
 - (e) inclusion of students with disabilities / special needs as per provision of act;
 - (f) the teachers are recruited with minimum qualifications, as laid under sub-section (1) of section 23; provided that the existing teachers who, at the time of commencement of the Act, do not posses the minimum qualifications, shall acquire such qualifications with in the period of 5 years from the date of commencement of the Act;
 - (g) the teachers perform their duties, specified under sub-section(1) of 24 of the Act; and
 - (h) The teachers shall not engage himself or herself in any private activities.
- The school shall follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum laid down by appropriate authority.
- 10. The school shall enroll students proportionate to the norms and standards available in the school as specified in section 19 of the Act.
- 11. The school shall maintain the standards and norms of the school as specified in section 19 of the Act. The facilities reported at the time of last inspection, if made, are as given under:-
